VAT's suppliers are required to only source smelters and refiners ("Smelters") in VAT's supply chain that source from a safe and responsible source and/or if the Smelter is classified "conflict-free" by an independent, third-party organization such as the Responsible Business Alliance Conflict Mineral Initiative.

Each VAT supplier is required to submit completed Responsible Minerals Initiative Conflict and Extended Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT/EMRT) statements demonstrating such supplier's commitment to the above and documenting countries of origin of tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold and other extended Conflict Minerals, such as cobalt and MICA that the supplier sources.

This VAT Conflict Minerals Statement is valid until September 20, 2024.
